

Faculty Position **Construction Engineering and Project Management**

The School of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Oklahoma State University is seeking applications for a tenured or tenure track faculty position as Assistant or Associate Professor with demonstrated expertise in construction engineering and management.

Candidates should have an earned doctorate in civil engineering, construction engineering and management, or a closely related field. The successful candidate should demonstrate excellence in teaching and commitment to externally funded scholarly research. Excellent opportunities exist for partnership with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, and Oklahoma Transportation Center, which is a designated national University Transportation Center (UTC) and currently is funded at the rate of \$3.5 M per year for five years. The ideal candidate will have a research focus in advanced construction technologies and infrastructure management technologies with a demonstrated expertise in one or more areas related to risk assessment, infrastructure rehabilitation, infrastructure health monitoring, innovative sensing approaches, information technology, sustainability, knowledge management, simulation and visualization. Superior communication and interpersonal skills, demonstrated leadership capabilities, and the ability to engage in collaborative research and to motivate and inspire students are required attributes. The school is seeking an outstanding individual who can demonstrate ability for graduate program administration and teaching various construction related courses. The successful candidate must be licensed as a Professional Engineer or be eligible to become licensed in Oklahoma within three years of appointment.

Oklahoma State University is located in Stillwater, Oklahoma, approximately 60 miles from both Oklahoma City and Tulsa. The school currently has 17 faculty members, 170 undergraduate students, and 60 graduate students.
